

**Freedom of Information Act
Affidavit of Intent**

Under the Freedom of Information Act 442 of 1976, Section 15.243, Sec. 13, subsection (2) states:

A public body shall exempt from disclosure...directory information, as defined by section 444 of subpart 4 of part C of the general education provisions act, title IV of Public Law 90-247, 20 U.S.C. 1232g, commonly referred to as the family educational rights and privacy act of 1974, requested for the purpose of surveys, marketing, or solicitation, unless that public body determines that the use is consistent with the educational mission of the public body and beneficial to the affected students. ...directory information disclosed under this subsection shall not be used, rented or sold for the purposes of surveys, marketing or solicitation. Before disclosing the directory information, a public body...may require the requester to execute an affidavit stating that directory information provided under this subsection shall not be used, rented, or sold for the purpose of surveys, marketing, or solicitation.
