

# *Senior Picture Requirements for the '08 Yearbook*



It's time for seniors to submit their senior pictures for the yearbook. Area photographers are taking appointments already.



It is imperative that the following specifications be used when ordering yearbook photos. While seniors can (and always have) received a variety of poses for their senior pictures, *the yearbook will only use a "head-and-shoulders" shot in the senior class "mug section."*

**The following specifications must be used in order for your senior picture to be printed in the 2007-2008 yearbook. Make sure that your photographer is aware of these specifications (Hint: Bring this sheet with you to your appointment).**

1. Yearbook portraits are to include *head and shoulders only*. Hands should not appear in these photos.
2. Students should be dressed in *formal attire* (dress shirts, sweaters, ties, blouses, etc.)
3. The student's **headsize should be approximately 1.25" to 1.5" from the bottom of the chin to the top of the head.** (Note photos on this page courtesy of Tom Mac's Photography)
4. Photos should be taken on a *basic background scheme*. The popular outdoor photos certainly are nice for friends and family; however, they are not suitable for the senior section of the yearbook. *Also, pictures that have names embossed on them CANNOT be accepted.*
5. Students need to **submit two WALLET sized photos to the yearbook staff by November 16, 2007.** While some photographers deliver photos to us, it is ultimately your responsibility to get them to the yearbook office on time. *Photos cannot be accepted late.* This date has been set by the yearbook publisher. Any photo turned in after this date will not appear in the yearbook. These photos will NOT be returned.
6. These submitted photos can be either black and white or color.
7. The high school yearbook does NOT submit these photos to the Saline Reporter. *It is your responsibility to give senior portraits to the local paper for their annual senior section.*
